Step 4

A Suggested Prayer

Dean’s “Good News” Story

I was born into a Christian family where I watched 3 generations of ancestry lead the musical worship at church by singing into a microphone on the platform. At an early age, I chose to accept the forgiveness offered by Jesus Christ and follow Him, and I made good life choices accordingly. However, in my late teens, I intentionally put God on a shelf with a promise to return after I had experienced many of the things I was told to never do.

During my senior year in college, two events caused me to reevaluate my life and my decision to shelve God. Second, I was at fault in a head on collision that totaled both vehicles and could have ended my life. The realization that I’d been given a second chance at life and knowing that Terri was the one for me drove me to my knees in repentance to receive God’s forgiveness. As promised in His Word, He forgave me and I returned to following Him with a fresh start. I’ve never gotten over it or looked back – Good News indeed!

Terri and I married in 1982 and have two sons, Adam and Kyle. I began my career in pest control in 1990 and became a partner with John Macy in 1996. John retired in 1998 and I became the sole owner of Macy’s Termite & Pest Control Company. At that same time, I was leading worship at our church as a volunteer with many people encouraging me to do so full time.

A close friend and mentor challenged me to operate the business as a “platform for ministry.” I had a vivid mental image of doing ministry from a church platform, but had no idea how to translate that to my business.
